New **SPEED LAW**

FEDERAL HIGHWAYS

MISSOURI SPEED LAW REQUIRES EVERY PERSON TO DRIVE IN A CAREFUL AND PRUDENT MANNER REGARDLESS OF SPEED LIMIT.

Every person operating a motor vehicle on the highways of this state shall drive in a careful and prudent manner and shall exercise the highest degree of care and control at all times, and shall conform to the posted speed limit or to the speed limit of the highway.

The driver shall exercise due care and shall not drive faster than is safe under the conditions existing at the time.

No person shall drive a motor vehicle on such a slow speed as to impede or block the normal and reasonable movement of traffic, except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with laws.
