A synopsis of the September 21, 2023 Cost Share Committee Meeting

Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Two projects were approved for \$1.2 million.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$0 available in state fiscal year 2024, \$25.1 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$33.7 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2027, and \$18.0 million available in state fiscal year 2028 for cost share projects.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$5.0 million available in state fiscal year 2024, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2027, and \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2028 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

MoDOT's Cost Share Program Partnerships Approved

City of Liberty - \$1,092,500 to construct intersection and sidewalk improvements along Route 291.

Wentzville School District - \$148,365 to construct traffic signal on Route DD at Frontier Middle School.
