

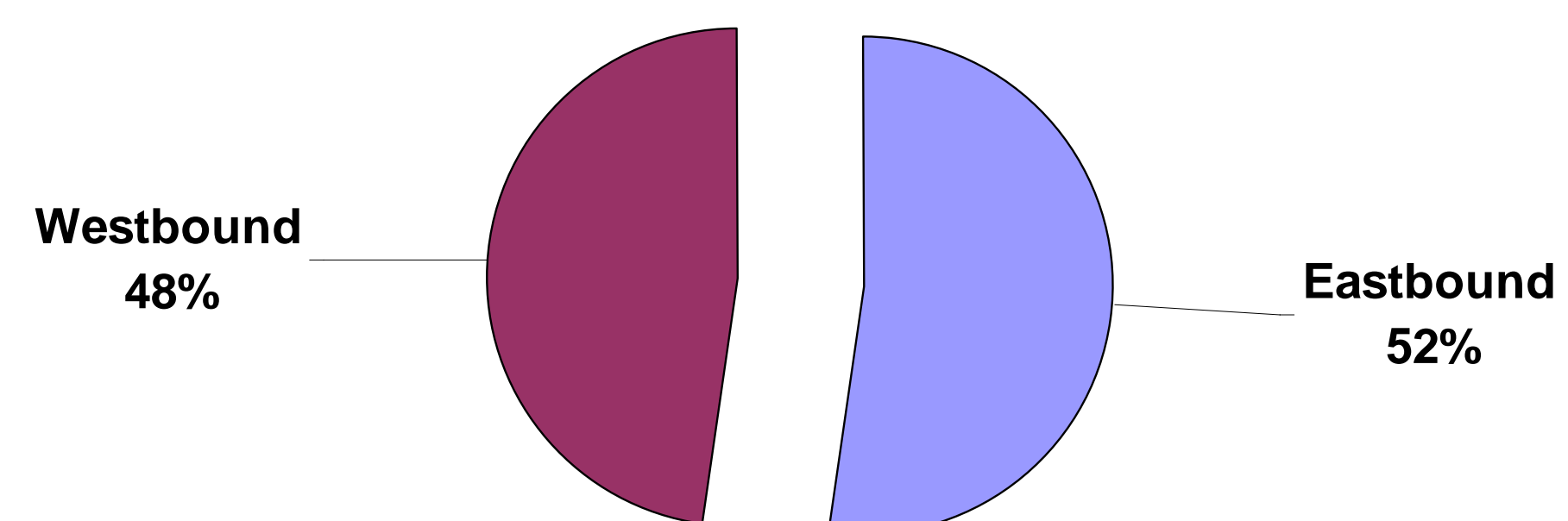

Crash Type Analysis

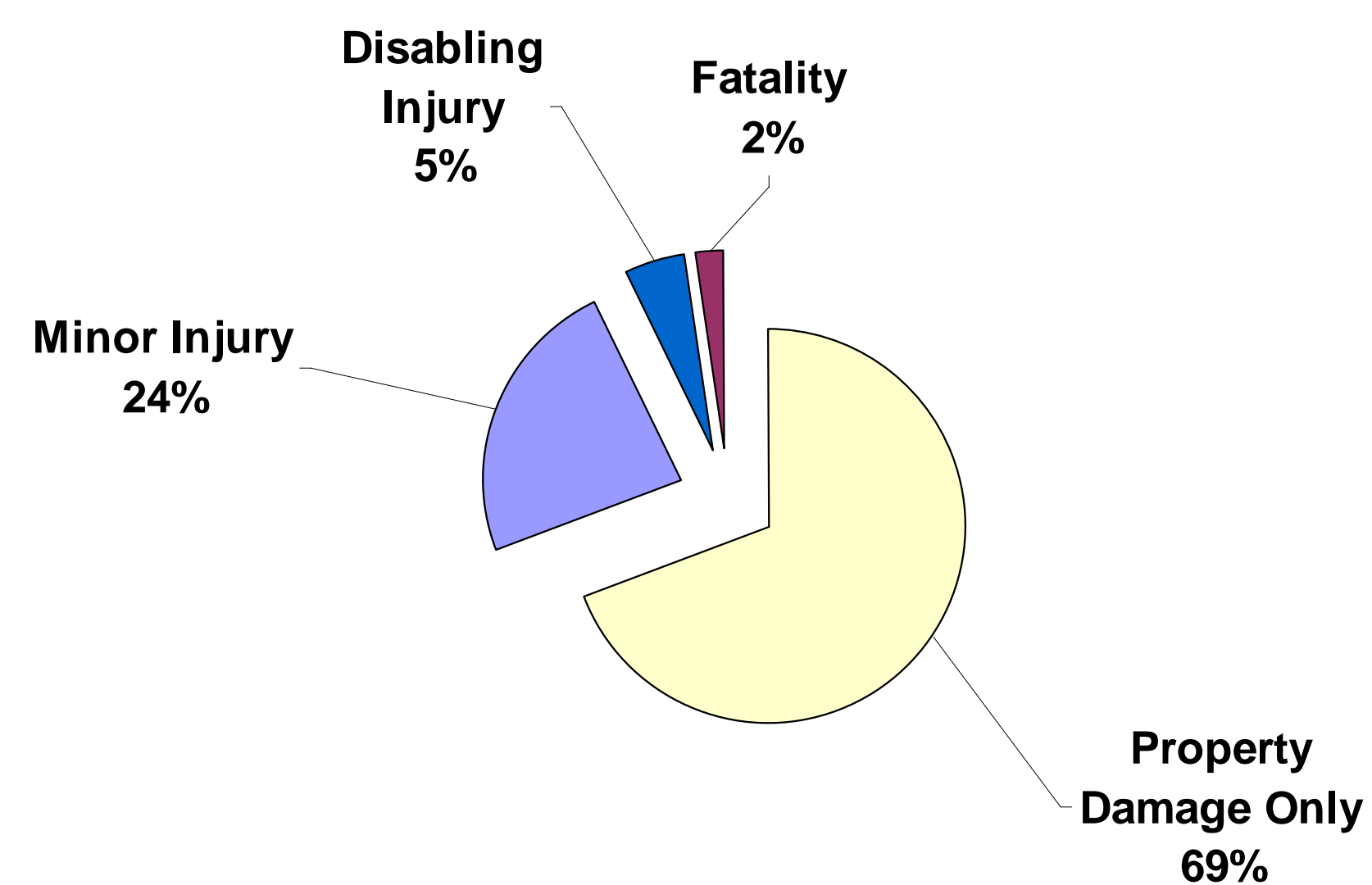
- Prevailing crash types noted above are indicative of unexpected, sudden stopping or reduced speed.

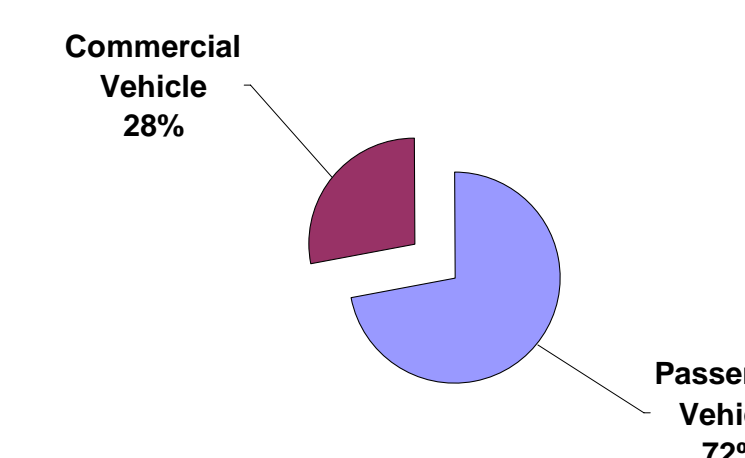
Crash Rate and Severity Analysis

- Jasper County and the I-44 Study Corridor's Fatality Rate is higher than the Missouri State Average for Interstates.

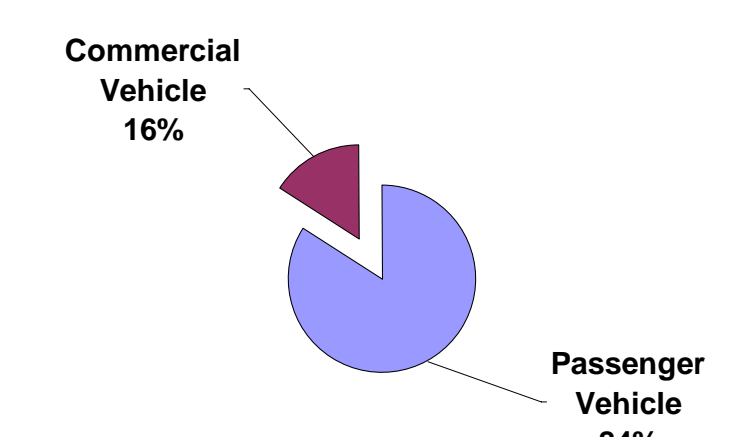
Commercial Vehicle Crashes in Jasper County

Crashes in which at least one vehicle involved was a commercial vehicle

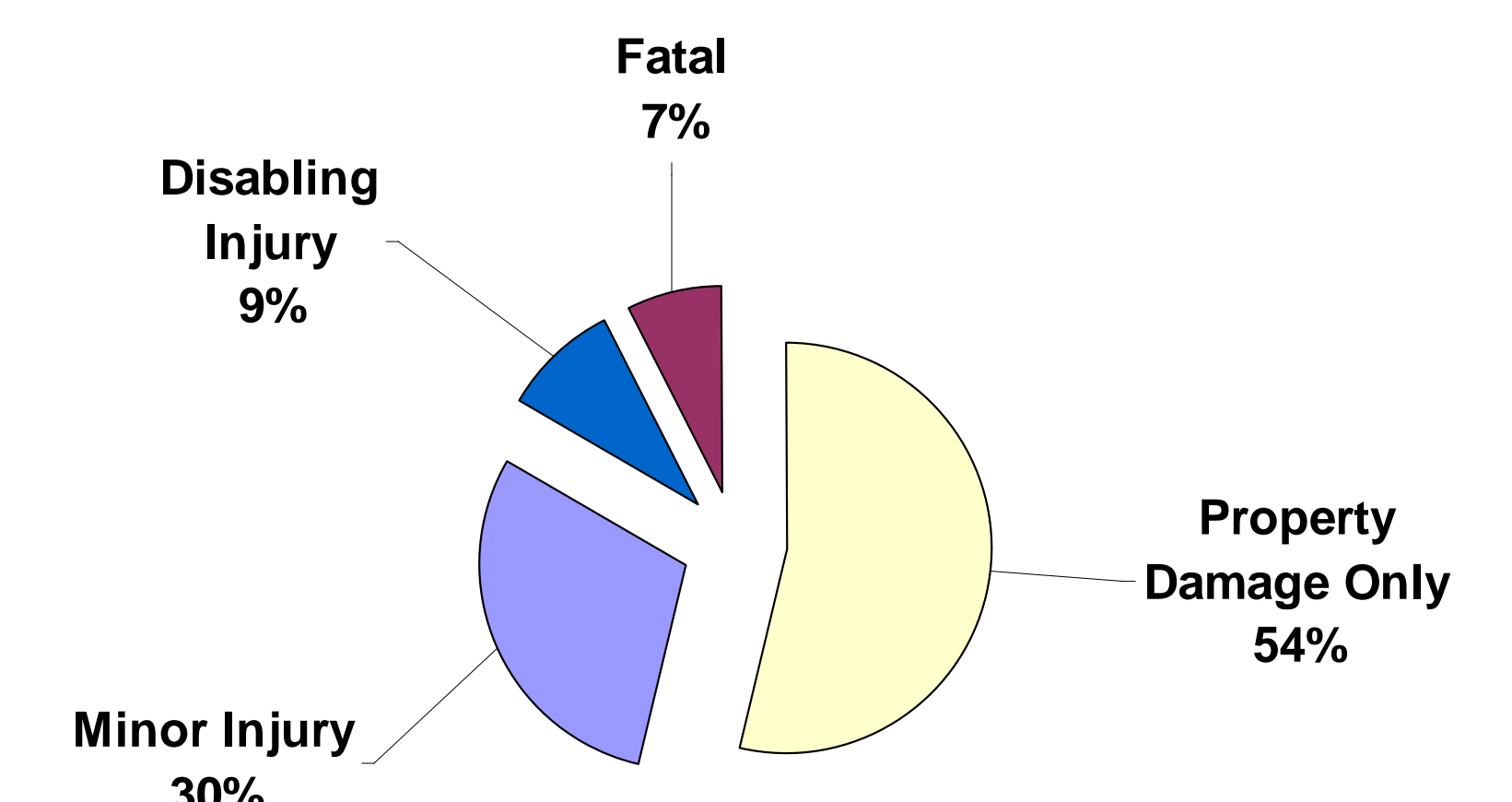

Commercial Vehicle Crash Analysis

- Commercial Vehicles account for 28% of the traffic volume in Jasper County, but are only involved in 16% of the crashes.
- Commercial Vehicle crashes tend to be more severe than passenger vehicle only crashes.
