PROJECT FACTS

- Resurface sections of U.S. Route 160 & Missouri Route 97 in Barton, Dade & Lawrence counties
- Project includes adding two (2) foot shoulders, rumble strips and repairing/resurfacing Route 160/North Fork Spring River bridge



CONSTRUCTION

- Construction to begin in Spring 2025
- Estimated Total Cost: \$10.8 million



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Drivers should expect delays where crews are working
- Traffic will be controlled by flaggers/pilot cars
- Detour for bridge work along routes VV, D & 160

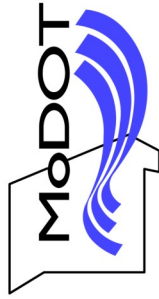


ADDITIONAL INFO

- Approximately 1,170 vehicles cross bridge daily

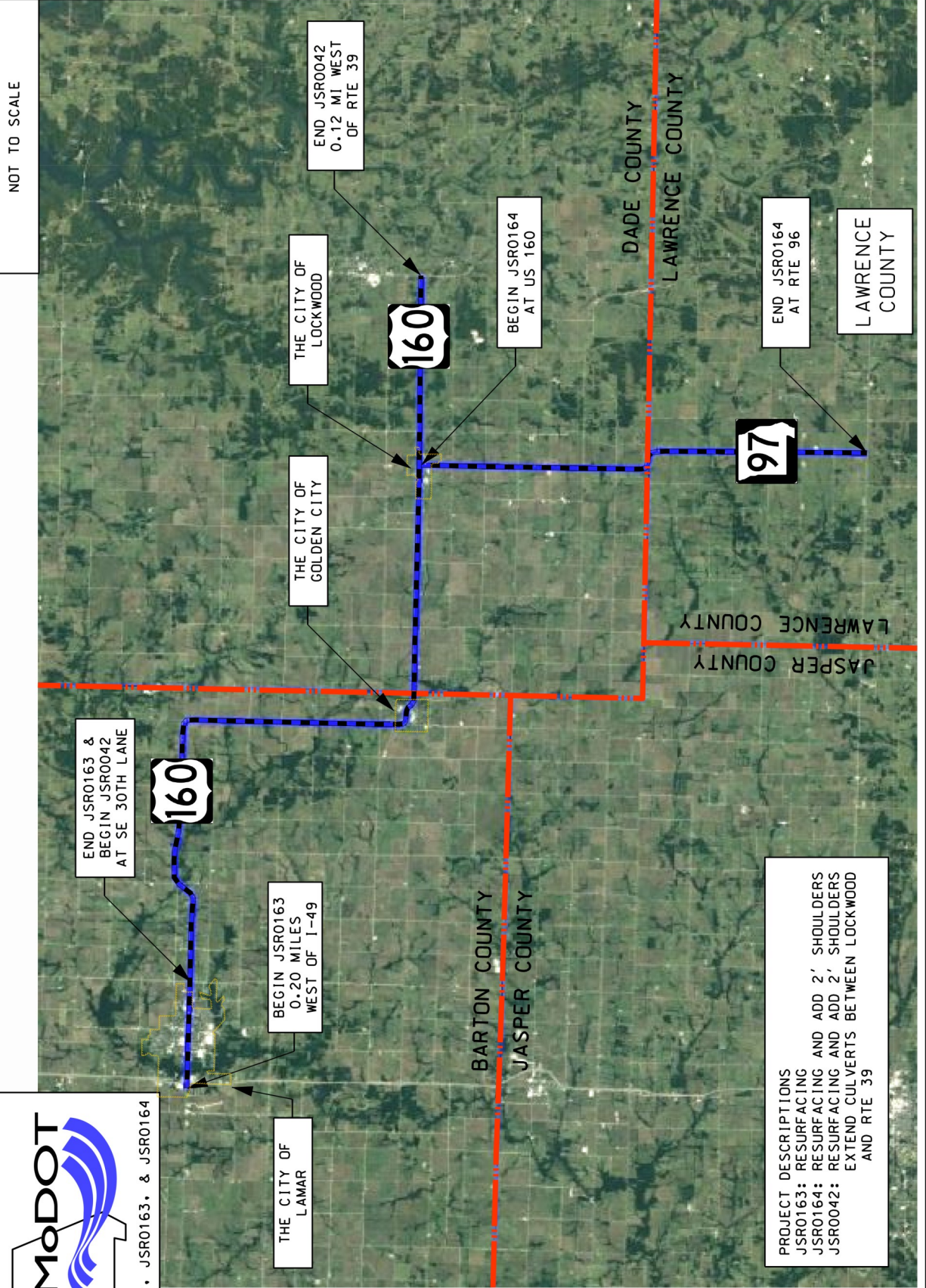
