



ROUTE V BRIDGE REPLACEMENT IN GREENE COUNTY

Over Clear Creek North of Ash Grove



PROJECT FACTS

- Replace Greene County Route V bridge over Clear Creek north of Ash Grove
- Widen bridge to 32 feet to be a dual-lane bridge
- New bridge will include new barrier wall, guardrail and permanent striping



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Route V CLOSED over Clear Creek for up to 4 months during construction
- Detour includes: Greene Count Route V, Missouri Route 123 and U.S. Route 160



CONSTRUCTION

- Project Awarded to Contractor: January 2024
- Construction Start Date: 2024
- Estimated Total Cost: \$3,069,000



BRIDGE FACTS

- Bridge built in 1936
- Bridge carries 1,813 vehicles a day
- Old bridge is a 20 feet wide, 275 feet long, single-lane bridge
- Current bridge in need of frequent repairs
