



## MISSOURI ROUTE 96/WHITE OAK CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT



### PROJECT FACTS

- Replace Missouri Route 96 bridge over White Oak Creek east of Avilla
- New bridge will be two feet higher, 16 feet wider, 15 feet longer



### CONSTRUCTION

- Project to be awarded to contractor in April 2022
- Estimated Total Cost: \$2,395,000
- Bridge will be CLOSED for up to 120 days



### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Signed truck detour: Missouri Routes 39 & 37, I-44
- Signed car detour: Jasper County routes U & F, Missouri Route 37



### BRIDGE FACTS

- Bridge built in 1925 with extensive rehabilitation in 1955
- Bridge carries approximately 3,800 vehicles per day (22% is truck traffic)
- Current bridge is 180 feet long and 28 feet wide
