General Summary The structural technician performs semi-skilled technical or paraprofessional duties in the preparation of detailed construction plans for highway bridges and related structures. Responsibilities are performed under moderate supervision.

Examples of Work

- (1) Prepares detailed construction plans for routine bridges, retaining walls and box culverts using computer aided drafting systems.
- (2) Computes elevations and structural dimensions from sketches and computations supplied by a designer.
- (3) Makes necessary revisions after plans have been checked or reviewed.
- (4) Computes reinforcing bar lists and quantities of materials needed for construction.
- (5) Prepares preliminary detailing for new projects.
- (6) Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
