

A synopsis of the March 27, 2008 IFSC Meeting

## **Summary of Program Activity**

- Two projects were approved for approximately \$1.1 million.
- □ The IFSC now has approximately \$22.7 million available for funding in FY 2012.

### **Partnerships Approved**

The IFSC funded the City of Aurora's project with \$119,000 in Cost Share funds to improve the intersection of MO 39 and Prospect Street by installing a signal and improving turning radii. This project will improve safety and traffic flow at the intersection.

City of Waynesville was approved for \$1,017,440 in Cost Share funds to relocate GW Lane Outer Road that currently runs parallel to I-44. This project will improve safety and mitigate traffic congestion. The City of Waynesville is accepting maintenance responsibilities of GW Lane.

# **Looking Ahead**

The IFSC's next meeting is scheduled for June 26, 2008. The deadline for applications is May 29, 2008.
